2. Do cows have accents?

Yes. Cows can have regional accents. After a group of dairy farmers noticed that their cows seemed to have different “moos,” language specialists determined that small herds have “dialectical variations” most affected by peer groups.

4. **T or F.** Cows face either magnetic north or south.

True. A German study found that cows face either magnetically north or south regardless of the sun’s position or the wind’s direction. There has been little study of the phenomenon and the reasons remain a mystery.

False. Unlike horses, cows do NOT sleep standing up. Their average sleep time per day is about four hours.

True. Researchers have found that when you name a cow and treat her as an individual, she will produce about 500 more pints of milk per year.
