One of those is his own, and he shared how close he came to selling out. He further understands what processors are also going through.

Chairman Brubaker thanked him for coming, and stressed how important it is to attend, to learn and hear the discussions with the farmers and processors, and the many interested parties within the industry.

Chairman Brubaker explained to those present that PMMB does not like to assess penalties, but we want folks to be licensed, and if done on time it saves time and money.

Mr. Cooper asked what is the calculation for a monthly hauler fee?

Attorney Saylor stated it is based on the volume of milk hauled in PA.

Tim Moyer stated the fee calculation to be .005 cents per hundredweight.
