3. Lancaster Farm Fresh Cooperative

DISCUSSION: Attorney Saylor presented **3. Legal Docket CL-17-042 Lancaster Farm Fresh Cooperative** for late filing of annual subdealer license renewal and fee and operating without a current license. A consent order was signed and a penalty of \$150.00 was paid.

Moved to accept the consent order as presented. (3. Legal Docket CL-17-042 for Lancaster Farm Fresh Cooperative) Seconded by Consumer Member Bowman.

DISCUSSION: Chairman Brubaker asked about Lancaster Farm Fresh Cooperative. Attorney Saylor said it is a nonprofit cooperative located in Lancaster marketing for over 100 family farms, including buying and selling packaged milk. Member Van Blarcom asked whether the penalty is more than the subdealer license fee. Attorney Saylor first explained that the license renewal form is mailed out in April and due by June 15, but typically citations are issued only if the company does not renew before July 1, because at that point they are operating without a license. The base subdealer license fee is \$75.00 with an additional fee based on sales volume.
