Enclosed are five (5) copies of prepared testimony and related material offered for presubmission by Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, relative to the aforementioned hearing.

Pennsylvania Farm Bureau intends to offer one witness for this hearing – Glenn Stoltzfus, Somerset County dairy farmer and Chair of Farm Bureau's State Dairy Committee. Mr. Stoltzfus's testimony will be consistent with prepared statement being offered today per Farm Bureau's presubmission.
